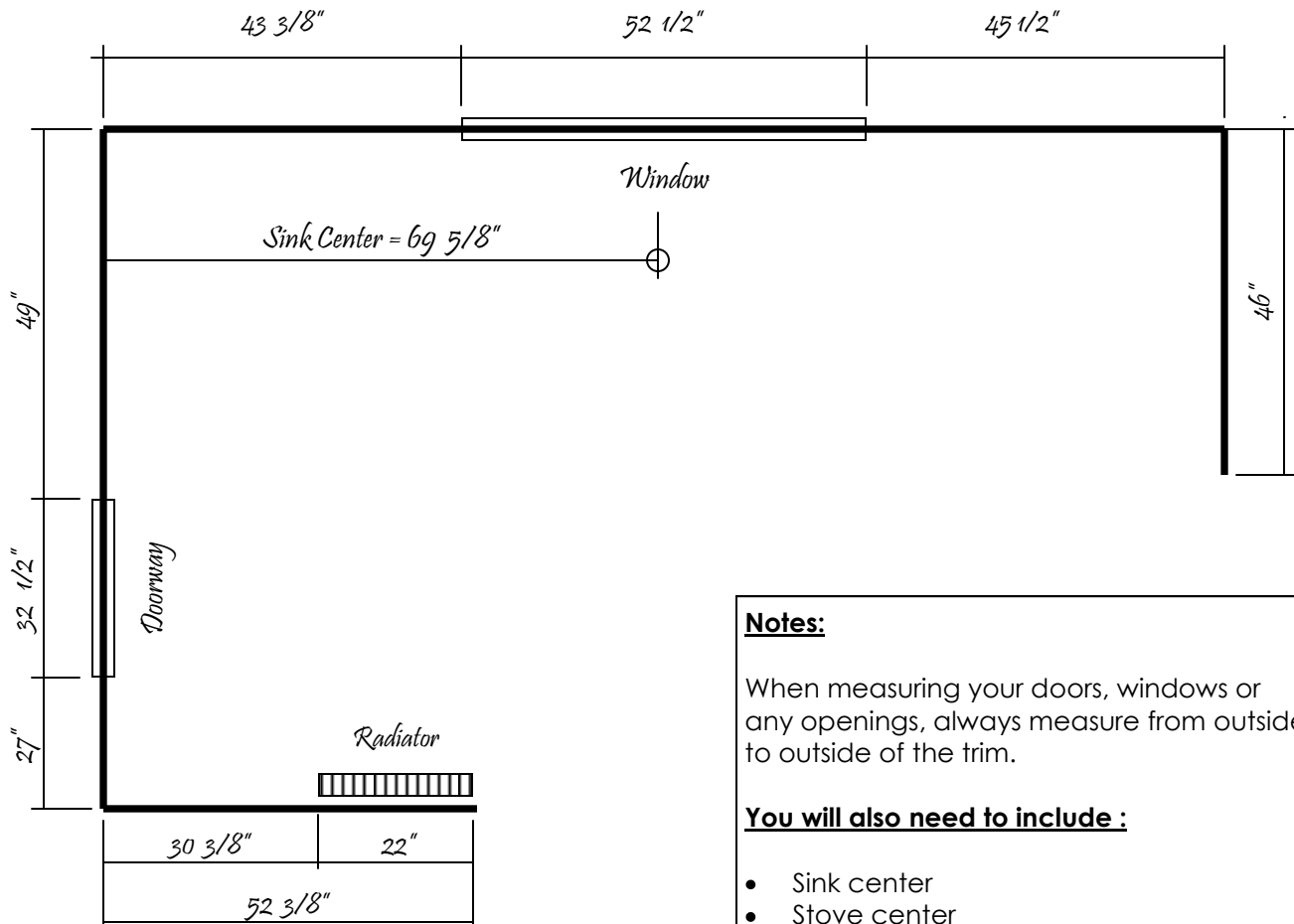


How to measure your Kitchen

- For a new construction, a set of architectural drawings of your house would provide adequate information to get a quote for your kitchen. However, before ordering the kitchen, our designer will have to go on site to take final measurements before sending the kitchen order to our manufacturing facility.
- For a renovation, you can follow our guidelines below and measure your space in order to get a quote. You can also arrange to have one of our designers visit your home and measure your kitchen if you feel more comfortable with this approach. Either way, if we install your kitchen, we will be visiting the site to confirm all measurements prior to ordering the kitchen.

Here is a guideline when measuring your kitchen



Notes:

When measuring your doors, windows or any openings, always measure from outside to outside of the trim.

You will also need to include :

- Sink center
- Stove center
- Ceiling height
- Appliances dimensions
- Any radiator locations.
- Bulkhead height
- Bulkhead dimensions
- Any obstructions in the space
